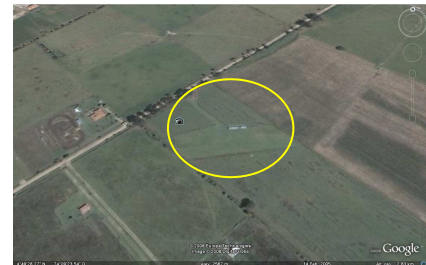
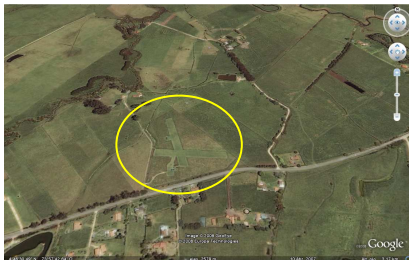
2. Food: Breakfast only
3. Transportation: All journeys. El Dorado airport - hotel - track.

3. ORGANIZERS: The organization of the event is in charge of Aeroclub 2600, www.aeromodelismocolombia.org and The Colombian Federation of Air Sports. The Club has appointed Mr. Alvaro Lahidalga as director of the event.

4. PLACE OF THE EVENT AND SITES OF PRACTICE: The competition will take place at Aeroclub 2600 located in the savannah of Bogota just 15 kilometers from the urban area, down the road that leads from the town of Suba to Cota. The runway 200 meters long and 20 wide, is in grass and is 2540 m above the sea level . In the clubhouse has enabled a room to house the aircraft at night unarmed.



During the week two other runways will be available for additional practice. One of them at the Club Tigres Voladores 25 km from Bogota down the road that leads from the township of La Calera to Sopó and the other at Club Vertigo 30 km from Bogota route to the town of Tenjo.



5. DATE OF THE EVENT: The official dates of the event are October 10, 11 and 12, 2008. The three runways will be available for training from October 6 and foreign pilots will have priority in their use. During unofficial training, control of frequencies will be the responsibility of the pilots.

- a. The FAI Sporting Code Section 4 2008 edition will be implemented.
- b. During the Model Processing participants may register as a second plane that of another participant.
- c. Measuring the noise level will take place on grass.
- d. 30% of the pilots will pass through to the final round.

8. CLAIMS: Any claim must be submitted to the Director of Event by the team manager of each country, written together with a deposit of \$ 50.
